Site Quality Control Manager responsible for supervising staff and maintaining quality control processes, analyzing the results, and giving feedback and guidance to the production team. Must insure and assist in determining if materials, product, and/or processes are in accordance with specifications. Ensure the staff follows the set processes and adheres to best production practices and product quality standards. Maintain site welder NDE and repair rates.

Site Quality Control Manager Minimum Requirements:

- 15+ Years' experience
- 5+ years supervision role
- Strong verbal and written communication skills with the Client and Coworkers within other departments.
- Proficient with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- Ability to promote a positive work environment.
- Must be able to multi-task and work in a fast-paced environment.
- Working knowledge of various ASME Code books including ASME B31.3, B31.1, Section I, Section VIII Div 1, and NBIC Code for Repairs and Alterations.
- Working knowledge to distinguish the Code Boundaries for Process Piping, Power Piping, and Code Repairs and Alterations.
- Ability to manage the activities of the site QC Department, including the night shift QC Supervisor. At times this may be up to 10 persons per shift.
- Oversees setting up NDE and witnessing hydro testing per package requirements.
- Interpret drawings and specifications for the purpose of establishing customers' critical needs.
- Check dimensions, final welds, and flange make-ups to ensure they meet all Client and Company Quality Standards.
- Inspect or direct personnel on the receiving requirements of materials, and document the findings of any defected materials.
- Assist with the assembly of documentation needed for turnover books for daily maintenance work orders, capital/expansion projects, and turnaround projects.
- Investigate customer complaints regarding quality issues and work with the Corporate Quality Manager to develop a solution.
- Other duties as required.
