CONTRACTOR SAFETY AWARDS BANQUET

JULY 14, 2023 - Sulphur, Louisiana – The Safety Council of Southwest Louisiana's annual Contractor Safety Performance Awards Banquet took place on Thursday, July 13th, 2023, at the West-Cal Arena and Events Center. This celebration recognizes the industry's dedication to cultivating and achieving a strong safety culture among contractors and the industry they support.

The Performance Awards are hosted in collaboration by the Southwest Louisiana Construction User's Council (SLCUC), Lake Area Industry Alliance (LAIA), and the Safety Council of Southwest Louisiana (SCSWLA).

The Keynote Speaker for the event was retired astronaut and USAF officer/pilot Mike Mullane. Mike joined NASA as one of the original space shuttle astronauts, flying three missions. He shared the human drama of space flight while highlighting the value of teamwork and individual responsibility in team safety. Dr. Wade Rousse, from McNeese State University, also presented at the event, providing a brief overview of the state of the LNG industry in our area, and their planned LNG facility.

Contractors considered for this award have challenged themselves to reach higher safety standards by instilling industry best practices. A rigorous grading method outlined by OSHA standards along with documented enforcement of safety regulations make up a point system by which the nominees are scored.

Awards are categorized by man hours worked and the type of work done. The *Best-in-Class Awards* are reserved for those companies that obtained the highest scores in each category, meeting minimum point requirements. Categories and awards presented at the banquet were as follows:
