Program Description


The Contractor Safety Performance Awards are a collaborative effort between the Health and Safety Council Louisiana, the Southwest Louisiana Construction User's Council (SLCUC) and the Lake Area Industry Alliance (LAIA). These organizations work together to cultivate a strong safety culture in our region. The overall goal of the Awards program is to encourage and recognize outstanding achievements in safety.

This, and every, year's Safety Awards celebrate the efforts of area contractors to prevent injuries and save lives in SWLA's industrial workplaces. Companies of all sizes will receive awards for exemplary safety execution, based on performance against eligibility criteria.

Awards will be presented to the companies that show a level of safety meeting and exceeding stringent criteria after close evaluation. Winners go beyond merely adopting a safety program – they demonstrate a serious, vigorous, and persistent commitment to safety culture.

The awards convey local industry's combined and full support of hands-on safety management by contractors, whose performance indicates recognition of their direct economic stake in the safety performance of their companies and the facilities they support.

Accident costs are a controllable business expense to owners and contractors alike, even beyond the potentially devastating consequence to individuals.



Categories

Awards will be presented in categories based on man-hours (business size) and business type:

Size:

- Category I 5,000 to 75,000 man hours
- Category II 75,001 to 500,000 man hours
- Category III Greater than 500,000 man hours


Note: Contractors embedded or working special projects at specific plants will be permitted to submit more than one nomination/application.

Type:

- General multiple work categories in IPQF (Construction and Maintenance)
- Specialty one work category/several in the same discipline (Safety, Inspections, etc.)
- Technical Support (Eng. I&E, others determined by judging committee)
- Other Contractors Vendor delivery, Employment services, or determined by judging committee

Best in Class:

 Best in Class (BIC) is awarded to the company with the top score in each category/size combination, presuming a set of minimum criteria is met.



Best-In-Class Award Highlights

The Best-In-Class awards are reserved for those companies that obtained the highest score in each category, while **also** meeting point requirement thresholds. Last year, we presented four best in class awards:



FAQs and Contact Information

- Q: Who can nominate a contractor for a Safety Award?
- A: Nominations can be submitted by an LAIA facility owner/
 representative, the Health and Safety Council Louisiana, SLCUC, or
 LAIA. In addition, safety-conscious contractors are encouraged
 to nominate themselves.
- Q: What are the requirements to be nominated?
- A: For a nominee to be considered for an award, they must have a current PQF as well as a PSM Audit on file with the Health and Safety Council Louisiana. They also must have a minimum of 5,000 man-hours worked in an LAIA facility. For a list of LAIA facilities, please visit <u>laia.com</u>.
- Q: Where do I go to nominate a contractor/myself?
- A: Our simple nomination form can be found <u>online</u>.
- Q: What happens after the nomination?
- A: The evaluation team from the Safety Council will review the required documentation in the nominee's IPQ and any additional information submitted (all due by May 15th). Information must be submitted in a binder or on a flash drive. The audit team may contact nominees for clarification or additional information.
